The Scottish mainland, which occupies roughly the northern third of the island of Great Britain, is bordered on three sides by seas. To the north and west is the Atlantic Ocean; to the east is the North Sea. Rugged uplands separate Scotland from England to the south. An independent nation for much of its history, Scotland was joined to England by a series of dynastic and political unions in the 17th and 18th centuries.
