4. Make your kids read daily and learn math at early age. During his five years studying the behaviors and habits of self-made millionaires, best-selling author Thomas Curley found that, "Sixty three percent of those self-made millionaires were required by their parents to read two or more books a month." The parents insisted their kid read biographies, history, nonfiction, literary classics or hobby books, and they quizzed them about what they had read. Curley believes not encouraging your children to read daily is "failing your kids." Besides encouraging your children to read, teach them math. In this book, he teaches readers how to build meaningful relationships by keeping yourself at top of mind with those around you. How To Teach Kids To Read. 1. Read Aloud to your child. Teaching your child to read is truly a process that begins at infancy. No, I am most certainly NOT advocating programs that claim to teach your baby to read using flashcards! How much you read to your child is completely up to you and your family, but I suggest you aim to read at least 3-4 books a day, even while your child is very young. As she gets a little older and can sit for longer stretches of time, make it a family goal to read together for at least 20-minutes each day. Here are a few suggestions for the types of books to read to your child. Realistic Fiction (a made-up story, but it could technically happen in real life because the characters and situations are believable). Alphabet Books. Song Books.
