It has been 323 years since the Salem Witchcraft Trials. People are still trying to determine why a court of law would have indicted, tried, found guilty, sentenced to death, and executed nineteen men and women in Salem village in 1692 for the alleged crime of witchcraft. In the September 7, 2015 issue of the New Yorker, Stacy Schiff's article, "The Witches of Salem: Diabolical doings in a Puritan village" says "In 1641, when the colonists established a legal code, the first capital crime was idolatry. The second was witchcraft. "If any man or woman be a witch, that is, has or consults with a
