It is based on analyzing image-text relationships in diverse environments: television news, children's picture books, textbooks, technical communication, newspapers, dictionaries, and multimedia, and Web pages. In stage 2, 30 functions were used to code the image-text pairs in the sample of Web pages. Hodnett's (1988) survey of book illustration, however, identifies three functional designations: to decorate, to inform, and to interpret, that most closely parallel the three used in the taxonomy.
